## GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF LICENSE





#### 1. Application, Definitions

- This General Terms and Conditions of License shall apply between Sprecher Automation GmbH or one of its affiliated companies ("Sprecher Automation") and a "Licensee". This General Terms and Conditions of License shall apply for all SPRECON®-E software products and the software product SPRECON®-V460.
- The General Terms and Conditions of License shall determine the terms and conditions of granting the object code - of the "computer programs respectively software from Sprecher Automation" including "software products from third parties" linked with those - from SPRECON®-V460, the related media, printed and digital respectively on-line documentation, Software-updates, addon-components, web-service and/or additional software codes etc. which Sprecher Automation will make available (hereinafter summarized as "Software"). The Software shall be licensed, not sold. Kind, amount, payment, operation environments and other conditions of the Software shall be agreed separately.
- Software-updates are new versions of the Software, which for example include corrected program deficiencies or minor program improvements. A Software-update shall replace or amend (or de-activate) the original Software. In case the Software-update is part of licensed Software, the Software-update shall only be used as part of the original Software.
- Software-maintenance and Software-upgrades are not subject of this General Terms and Conditions of License. For this purpose, the conclusion of a separate SPREcare Service-Level-Agreement between Sprecher Automation and the Licensee is recommended. Software-maintenance benefits include for example hotline or on-site-services. Software-upgrades are new versions of the Software, which include additional functions.
- By installing respectively using the Software, the Licensee declares to have read and understood this General Terms and Conditions of License and to be bound by them.
- The License shall be not entitled to install and use the Software if the Licensee has not accepted this Terms and Conditions. In this case termination shall take place.
- The General Terms and Conditions of License shall be amended, modified or replaced by special conditions, e.g. individual agreements, product terms, terms of third parties etc, depending on the kind of utilization, which shall be confirmed before utilization, as required.
- The General Terms and Conditions of License shall explicitly not apply for software products from third parties. For software products from third parties the terms of use of the respective licensor shall be obligatory.
- In case of contradictions in the contract documents following order of precedence shall apply: (a) individual agreements, if confirmed by Sprecher Automation in writing; (b) this General Terms and Conditions of License; (c) non-mandatory provisions of the commercial law and civil law.
- 1.10. Third party shall mean any person, other than Sprecher Automation and the Licensee ("contract partners"), even if such third party is related to a contract partner in any way.

### **Rights and Obligations of Use**

Licensee is granted a non-transferable (in case of a partner license a transferable), non-exclusive, with regard to the subject matter limited, timely unlimited right for using the object code of the Software as specified in the conditions of this General Terms and Conditions of License on the number of workstations on the facility respectively as per agreed project mentioned in the individual agreement. Any and all other rights related to the Software remains with Sprecher Automation respectively third parties. Unless Sprecher Automation's prior written consent is received and irrespective of the conditions of §40d of the Austrian Copyright Act

- (UrhG) respectively as per applicable license-, copy right law and/or agreement regarding intellectual property Licensee is in particular not entitled to reproduce, modify, entirely (except in case of a partner license acc. clause 2.3.) or partly disclose the Software to third parties, lease, rent or make available commercial hosting service to third parties. The Software license shall not be shared.
- Alternatively to the conditions as outlined in clause 2.1. the Licensee shall be entitled to install the Software on a storage device, e.g. network server, and permit employees of the Licensee, to access and use the Software from another device via a secured connection, under the condition the Licensee has acquired the Software for the storage device and for the other devices for this special kind of usage. The Software shall not be used on multiple devices at the same time.
- The Software shall be used with hardware and systems, which comply with the defined minimum standards of the Software. In case of replacement of the hardware, Licensee is entitled to continue utilization of the Software to the extent of this General Terms and Conditions of License on the new hardware, which shall be explicitly approved by Sprecher Automation for the Software, without the need for new Terms and Conditions of License.
- Licensee has the right, to buy a so-called partner license, what means, he is entitled, to transfer the Software one-time and permanently directly to an end-customer by binding contract, with the obligation to observe the obligations of this General Terms and Conditions of License, including the obligation, not to transfer the Software. In this case, Licensee shall bear the sole liability for the selection of the Software and the operation environments near the end-customer, unless no other separate agreement is made.
- Licensee is obliged, to use the Software and the information and documentation received in this context exclusively according the respective agreement and, not to exploit the Software, neither during nor after termination of the respective agreement (respectively upon completion of use) and, not to gain access to third parties.
- 2.6. The Licensee is not entitled, to copy, change, amend, edit, re-develop, decompile or disassemble the Software, to unlink single components, to use the Software on more as the agreed number of workstations and to use the Software commercially or make the Software available to third parties.
- Demo Software shall be used only for the purpose of evaluation. No license shall be granted with a demo software, commercial utilization shall be excluded.

#### 3. Scope of Delivery, Performance and Function

The scope of delivery, performance and function shall be described in the respective description from Sprecher Automation and as defined on the date of entering into the agreement. Special deliveries, performances or functions of the Software, for example statements on capacity, time response, compatibility with other programs, cross-linking possibilities, individual adaptations of the Software to other programs or other special operation conditions shall be agreed on a case by case basis in written form.

#### 4. **Documentation**

- The Licensee will get from Sprecher Automation documentation for utilization of the Software, for example a functional description, a description for use respectively general information for installation of the program at time point of delivery or taking over of the Software, in case taking over is agreed. The documentation will be made available in English language in one copy either in machine readable or printed form, if applicable in form of a digital or on-line-documentation.
- Documentation, records and the like, made available in written form shall not be reproduced without explicit prior written consent from Sprecher Automation. In case such consent is given by Sprecher Automation, reproductions shall be clearly marked with

a reference to Sprecher Automation 's copy right. The Licensee shall be entitled to make one copy of documentations, which are provided only in electronic format.

### 5. Backup Copies

5.1. Licensee is entitled to reproduce a backup copy of the machine-readable program of the Software, also clearly marked with a reference to Sprecher Automation's copy right and to store it for archive purposes.

#### 6. License Fee

6.1. The right to use the Software shall be granted only after complete fulfillment of any and all obligations (in case of delay in payment including interest and additional liabilities). Unless not agreed different, the license fee is payable within 30 days after date of invoice, net, without any deduction. Any taxes and duties outside Austria shall be on the account of the Licensee, as far as applicable.

#### 7. Deliveries

7.1. Licensee will obtain the Software on a machine-readable medium in the agreed version including the documentation as stipulated in the individual agreement.

#### 8. Return and Destruction

- 8.1. Sprecher Automation shall be entitled to withdraw the right to use with immediate effect, in case Licensee infringes repeatedly and grossly negligent against substantial conditions of this General Terms and Conditions of License, despite written warnings. In this case, Licensee has no right of reimbursement of the license fee. Licensee is obliged to immediately inform Sprecher Automation of any violation done by a third party and to pursuit the injury on request of Sprecher Automation.
- 8.2. Upon termination of the use or upon expiry of the period of use, the Licensee is obliged, at Sprecher Automation's option, either to return Sprecher Automation the entire Software including any documentation and hard lock made available with it or demolish it by providing the proof of destruction. This obligation shall apply also to software that has been modified or combined with other parts.

### 9. Copyright, Intellectual Property Rights

- The Software is proprietary. Any and all Copyright and Industrial Property Right regarding the Software (including but not limited to codes, pictures, brands, photos, animations, video, music, text and "applets", which is contained in the Software), and regarding the documentation, license management tools and copies remain at every time at Sprecher Automation respectively respective third parties. Any and all Copyright and Industrial Property Right regarding contents, which are not included in the Software, but which can be accessed with help of the Software, remain with the respective owner of the content and may be protected by applicable license-, copy right law and/or agreement regarding intellectual property. Licensee shall have no right for use of such contents. Licensee shall in no case obtain the source code and shall not acquire any rights thereto. Licensee is obliged, to protect respectively to retain unchanged any and all rights of Sprecher Automation respectively the third parties.
- 9.2. Licensee is obliged, to immediately inform Sprecher Automation in case of an asserted infringement of industrial property right in writing and do everything in its power that Sprecher Automation can hold off the asserted infringement of industrial property. In case of infringement claims against Sprecher Automation, for which Sprecher Automation may be held responsible, Sprecher Automation may, at its own expense modify or replace the Software or obtain the right to use it. It this cannot be done at reasonable costs, Licensee shall, at Sprecher Automation's request, without delay return the originals and all copies of the Software, including any documentation made available to Licensee. Herewith all claims from the Licensee shall be fully and definitely settled with regard to the infringement of industrial property right and

the copyright, and Sprecher Automation shall have no further obligation to Licensee.

- 9.3. Sprecher Automation reserves the right to examine the agreed use of the software itself, or through a commissioned third parties ("subcontractors"), within the context of an audit, provided that 14 days advance written notice of the audit has been given. The licensee shall be obliged to cooperate in the audit and to grant Sprecher Automation or the subcontractors sufficient access to information related to the use of the software (e.g. server, business books, etc.). Any underpaid licence fees shall be paid within 14 days after written request. In addition, Sprecher Automation shall be entitled to terminate the individual agreement extraordinarily. The cost of the audit shall be agreed separately.
- 9.4. The SPRECON®-V460 software product contains following open source software components, which are protected by copyright:

- 9.5. Some software components of the Software SPRECON®-V460 use open source libraries. For this libraries the conditions according to manual "Open\_Source\_Software\_License\_Information.pdf" shall be applicable, which are stored and downloadable on the machine-readable medium and also in the installation directory of the software products.
- 9.6. The SPRECON®-E software products PLC designer contains following open source software components, which are protected by copyright:
- Binutils, GCC and GNU Make; subject to the GNU General Public License (GPL). A copy of the applicable license terms is downloadable under: <a href="http://www.gnu.org/copyleft/gpl.html">http://www.gnu.org/copyleft/gpl.html</a>.
- 9.7. Some software components of the SPRECON®-V460 software product use Microsoft SQL Server Standard licences. For this product the conditions of the "EULA\_Microsoft\_SQL\_Server\_EN.rtf" shall be applicable, which are stored and downloadable on the machine-readable medium and also in the installation directory of the software products. In case a Microsoft SQL Server Standard licence should be part of the purchased product, the number and type of licences are shown on the licence certificate.
- 9.8. The Microsoft SQL Server Standard licences supplied with SPRECON®-V460 software products may only be used in conjunction with the SPRECON®-V460 software product.
- 9.9. The Software contains license management tools, which are stored and downloadable on the machine-readable medium as well as described in the manual "Licensing.pdf", which is contained in the machine-readable medium and also in the installation directory.

- 9.10. The usage of the license management tools shall be solely at the discretion of the user.
- 9.11. In case that the Software product contains license management tools of third parties or that license management tools refer to websites of third parties, the tools and references are solely made available for the comfort of the user. The user shall use those explicitly at his own risk. Any liability of Sprecher Automation shall be excluded

#### 10. Warranty

- 10.1. Sprecher Automation warrants, that the Software, at the time point of delivery, is not afflicted with deficiencies, which revoke or reduce the operational capability compared with the valid functional description from Sprecher Automation at the time of the conclusion of the individual agreement, provided that the Software is used in accordance with the valid installation requirements and used with the valid operation conditions. Irrelevant discrepancies shall be unaffected. The obligation to update digital services as well as goods with digital elements is excluded unless explicitly agreed.
- 10.2. The warranty from Sprecher Automation comprises error identification and elimination of errors respectively fault repair during the warranty period. The warranty period is 12 months and shall commence with readiness of delivery, unless not agreed otherwise.
- 10.3. Any deficiencies respectively malfunctions, these are functions deviating from the valid functional description from Sprecher Automation at the time of the conclusion of the individual agreement, shall be disclosed to Sprecher Automation immediately and in a traceable written manner. Functions in need of improvements or user faults respectively malfunctions caused through Force Majeure shall not be considered as defects in term of the General Terms and Conditions of License.
- 10.4. Elimination of errors respectively malfunctions shall be done under the sole option of Sprecher Automation by delivering new Software or by modification of the already delivered Software. Elimination of errors shall be conditional (a) upon the error being an error resulting in malfunction, (b) upon the error being reproducible, (c) upon any new version offered to Licensee free of charge within the warranty period having being installed, (d) upon Sprecher Automation receiving from the Licensee all documentation and information necessary for eliminating the error and (e) upon Sprecher Automation being given access to the hardware and Software during Sprecher Automation's normal working hours.
- 10.5. The warranty shall not apply in case Licensee or third parties have modified the Software without Sprecher Automation's prior written consent, even if the error occurs in a part of the Software not modified. If, during error identification, it is detected that the case in question is not covered by warranty or that the cause of the error is not due to the Software supplied, Licensee shall bear all costs that may be accrued at Sprecher Automation.
- 10.6. Sprecher Automation shall not warrant, (i) that the Software functions meet Licensee's requirements, (ii) that the programs and configuration of the Software selected by the Licensee work together, (iii) that the programs work continuously and without errors or (iv) that all Software errors can be eliminated.
- 10.7. If, despite sustained efforts of Sprecher Automation, Sprecher Automation is not able to trace the error or is not able to bypass the error in a way, that the Software can be used according the functional description, within a reasonable period, either contract partner may terminate the agreement for the Software immediately by returning of all goods and reimbursement of services received, unless it is not an insignificant error.
- 10.8. Deficiencies respectively malfunction in one or some of the parts of the Software shall not entitle Licensee to terminate the General Terms and Conditions of License with respect to other parts.

#### 11. Liability, Insurance, Force Majeure

- 11.1. Claims against Sprecher Automation (incl. penalties) may only be asserted in the event of proven fault on the part of Sprecher Automation. Sprecher Automation shall be liable for damages within the scope of the Product Liability Act, for damages due to proven intent as well as personal injuries within the limits of statutory provisions. Sprecher Automation shall not be liable for damages due to acts of ordinary negligence. In case of gross negligence the liability including all penalty a shall be limited to the net value of the Software. In case of negligence, Sprecher Automation shall not be liable for consequential damages or damages for pure economic loss, indirect damages, loss of production, financing costs, costs for replacement energy, loss of energy, data or information, loss of profits, loss of savings or interest, or damage resulting from third party claims against the Licensee. Claims that exceed the agreed contractual penalties are excluded from the respective title. As far as the liability for Sprecher Automation is excluded, Sprecher Automation's representatives, servants and/or assignees have the same status.
- 11.2. Liability claims against Sprecher Automation are under the statute of limitations at the latest 24 months after readiness for delivery, unless mandatory statutory provisions provide for other periods.
- 11.3. Sprecher Automation shall not be liable for any damages in case of non-compliance with instructions for installation, use or the official approval conditions.
- 11.4. Sprecher Automation shall not assume any liability for dysfunctions at the Licensee not caused by Sprecher Automation, although they are in timely closeness to installation or utilization of the Software. Sprecher Automation shall not assume any liability for interference or failures on the computer system of Licensee, for loss of data due to technical malfunction, interrupted data communication or other interferences or failures, which can arise by utilization or installation of the Software.
- 11.5. In case of a special risk of any damage at the Licensee, which cannot be identified by Sprecher Automation, the Licensee shall inform Sprecher Automation and shall itself take out and maintain an appropriate insurance coverage at its own expense.
- 11.6. In case Licensee exceeds the contractually stipulated limits of rights or Licensee violates duties as per Clause 2. (Rights and Obligations of Use), 8. (Return and Destruction), 9. (Copyright, Intellectual Property Rights) and 12. (Secrecy) of the General Terms and Conditions of License, Sprecher Automation shall be entitled to claim all and any damages due to this.
- 11.7. Any extension, delay or suspension of the agreed time schedule, not caused by or within the responsibility of Sprecher Automation, as well as events of Force Majeure and/or events in connection with the spread of the "Coronavirus" or other infectious diseases/pandemics, shall postpone any deadlines, that Sprecher Automation cannot comply with, for the duration of the effect, irrespective whom the effect concerns. No claims of the Licensee can be asserted resulting from such delays (liquidated damages, consequential damages, failures etc.).

#### 12. Secrecy

12.1. Licensee undertakes to use all trade and business secrets, data, drawings, technical specifications, materials provided, documentations and information of any kind, which he receives in connection with this General Terms and Conditions of License or which he receives or become aware in the course of the contractual co-operation, confidential, not to copy or exploit them, not to disclose the same to third parties or make them available elsewhere. This shall not apply if this information are lawfully available to the public, generally or otherwise lawfully know, or approved for release in writing by Sprecher Automation. The Licensee shall impose the above obligation on their staff and auxiliary persons accordingly. The secrecy obligation shall continue after termination of the individual agreement for a period of 7 years.

12.2. Licensee is permitted to refer to the contractual co-operation in marketing material and publication, irrespectively of the kind, only after he has got the expressly prior written confirmation from Sprecher Automation.

#### 13. Compliance with Export Regulations

- 13.1 When passing on the Software supplied by Sprecher Automation (e.g. in the case of a partner licence), the Licensee shall comply with the respective applicable provisions of national and international (re-)export regulations, irrespective of the manner of making available or passing on the deliveries and services provided by Sprecher Automation, including technical support of any kind to third parties. In any case, when passing on the Software or services to third parties, the Licensee shall comply with the (re-)export regulations of the country in which Sprecher Automation has its registered office, the European Union, the United Kingdom of Great Britain, China and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.
- 13.2 If required for export control checks, the Licensee shall immediately provide Sprecher Automation upon request with all necessary information, including information about the final recipient, final destination and intended use of the Software or services.
- 13.3 The performance of the contract by Sprecher Automation is subject to the proviso that no obstacles due to national or international (re-)export regulations, in particular no embargos and/or other sanctions, prevent performance.

#### 14. Other Provisions

14.1. If individual provisions of the General Terms and Conditions of License and/or the individual agreements concluded hereunder are or become ineffective respectively unenforceable in whole or in part, the effectiveness and enforceability of the remaining provisions of the General Terms and Conditions of License and/or the

individual agreements concluded hereunder shall not be affected thereby. In such case the ineffective respectively unenforceable provision shall be deemed replaced by a provision, which is as similar as possible to the intended purpose. The same shall apply mutatis mutandis if a gap is identified.

- 14.2. In order to be effective any and all modifications and amendments including this Clause shall be made in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both partners.
- 14.3. A transfer of rights and obligations to third parties shall require the prior express written consent of Sprecher Automation.
- 14.4. Sprecher Automation warrants observance with the applicable data protection regulations. Information about data protection is available under <a href="https://www.sprecherautomation.com/en/gdpr/">https://www.sprecherautomation.com/en/gdpr/</a>.
- 14.5. The requirement of written form in the sense of these conditions is granted in any text form (letter, e-mail, fax, etc.), unless stricter formal requirements are required by law or agreement (e.g. authorised signature, signature on the original, notarial act, etc.)

### 14. Applicable Law, Jurisdiction

- 14.1. Austrian law shall apply exclusively to all legal transactions, in particular those subject to these General Terms and Conditions of License. The conflict of laws rules of private international law and UN Sales Law (CISG) are hereby expressly excluded.
- 14.2. The Place of jurisdiction for all legal disputes arising from or in connection with the contractual relationship shall be exclusively the competent court for Linz/Austria. Sprecher Automation shall be entitled, at its discretion, to sue the User at any other court, that may be competent according to national or international law.
